BACKGROUND

Dr Diamond began his training at the General Hospital in Cheltenham. He then completed his fellowship training in glaucoma and anterior segment surgery at the Royal Perth Hospital before continuing to the world-renowned Bristol Eye Hospital. Here, he was appointed as a consultant in 1996, and then founded and ran the glaucoma department for 20 years.

Committed to ongoing excellence within the field of ophthalmology, Dr Diamond also co-founded Newmedica – the largest private provider of eyecare to the National Health Service (NHS) – and established the biggest group practice of eye surgeons in the UK. As such, he is well-placed to provide premier, high-quality care to his patients.

A committed medical researcher, Dr Diamond has authored over 50 research papers and textbook chapters and achieved a PhD in the field of ophthalmology research. His dedication to highquality research has also helped him secure eleven research grants to fund future scientific research in the field.
