Our clinic is equipped with the latest advances in ophthalmic technology, along with spacious waiting areas and modern patient amenities. Specialist diagnostic equipment complements our state-of-the-art laser technology to ensure that each patient receives a customised outcome for optimal results.

We are also located within the recently refurbished RiverCity Private Hospital to ensure patient convenience and continuity of care when surgical procedures are required.

## CATARACT & LENS SURGERY



Cataract treatment involves keyhole surgery to remove the cloudy lens, which is replaced with an artificial intraocular lens. Cataract surgery is the most common eye surgery performed in the world and has a high success rate. Dr Lenton offers bulk-billing for cataract surgery\*. In some cases, he can help patients get rid of their reading glasses by using the latest lens options.



## LASER EYE SURGERY



Laser eye surgery involves using a cool-temperature laser to reshape the cornea and correct vision. Dr Lenton performs LASIK and ASLA/PRK and will advise which option is best suited to your situation. This will depend on whether you have short-sightedness, long-sightedness or astigmatism, and the thickness and health of your cornea.

### LASIK

LASIK is the most common type of laser eye surgery performed worldwide. The surgeon creates a hinged flap to expose the tissue bed underneath, then uses an excimer laser to reshape the cornea. After reshaping is complete, the surgeon gently replaces the flap and the healing process begins.

### ASLA/PRK

ASLA is particularly suited to people with thin or irregular corneas. The surgeon applies a topical solution to soften and remove the top layer of corneal cells, then uses an excimer laser to reshape the cornea. After this, a 'bandage' contact lens is placed on top of the eye to assist with the healing. This is removed 3–5 days after surgery.

## CORNEAL CONDITIONS



Dr Lenton manages diseases that affect the surface of the eye, including dry eye, red eye, corneal ulcers and chronic conjunctivitis. He specialises in pterygium (Surfer's Eye) and is highly experienced at pterygium removal.

## GENERAL EYE HEALTH



Patients can also have a comprehensive eye check at our clinic and treatment for more general eye conditions.

### No 'hidden fees' at our clinic

Our quote includes the pre-surgical consultation, your procedure, medications, 6 months of post-operative care and any enhancements (if needed) within 2 years of the initial surgery.

# CONVENIENTLY LOCATED

Our clinic is located only 2.5 kilometres west of Brisbane's CBD and is easily accessible by car. There is a multi-level carpark on-site (enter via Wienholt St). Street parking is also available on Munro St, Wienholt St, Grimes St and Ridley St.

Bus route 470 (City-Toowong) stops opposite our clinic at the corner of Milton Rd and Grimes St (stop 10), and Auchenflower Railway Station (Ipswich/Springfield line) is a 5-minute walk away.

For people with limited mobility, the multi-level carpark provides easy access to our clinic reception.
