FULL-SERVICE CLINIC

Dr Loane diagnoses and treats a range of eye conditions, including those described below. After your initial consultation, our expert clinical staff will be available to answer your questions and to help you make an informed decision about your eye care.

CATARACT & LENS SURGERY



Cataract surgery is the most common eye surgery performed in the world and has a high success rate. It involves keyhole surgery to remove the cloudy lens, which is replaced with an artificial intraocular lens, or IOL. Dr Loane also uses IOLs in patients without cataracts to correct refractive errors, including short-sightedness, long-sightedness and/or astigmatism.

Dr Loane uses the latest IOL technology, including the Zeiss IOLMaster 700 power measuring technology, Zeiss lenses and the Zeiss Calisto operating microscope to achieve excellent visual outcomes. Most of the time, he can help patients to get rid of their glasses.

GLAUCOMA



While glaucoma cannot be cured, treatments can generally stabilise or slow disease progression. Increased pressure inside the eye causes damage to the optic nerve and leads to irreversible vision loss. Treatment involves lowering eye pressure by improving fluid drainage.

Most patients can manage their glaucoma with medicated eye drops, but sometimes another type of treatment may be necessary. These could include laser treatment, filtration surgery or minimally invasive glaucoma surgery (e.g. iStent) combined with cataract surgery to improve fluid drainage from the eye.

CORNEAL CONDITIONS



Dr Loane manages a range of conditions that affect the cornea and front of the eye, such as iritis, corneal ulcers, recurrent corneal erosion, corneal dystrophy, corneal infection and pterygium (Surfer's Eye).

RETINAL CONDITIONS



Using the latest diagnostic equipment, Dr Loane can assess the health of a patient's retina, and diagnose and monitor retinal conditions. For certain treatments or surgery, patients may need to be further referred to a retinal specialist.

GENERAL EYE HEALTH



Patients can also have a comprehensive eye check at our clinic, including macular and retinal scans, and treatment for most general eye conditions.

CONVENIENTLY LOCATED

Car: Our clinic is located in the RiverCity Private Hospital, only 2.5 kilometres west of Brisbane's CBD and is easily accessible by car. There is a multi-level carpark on-site with free 4-hour parking (enter via Wienholt St).

Bus: Bus route 470 (City-Toowong) stops opposite the hospital at the corner of Milton Rd and Grimes St (stop 10).

Train: Auchenflower Railway Station (Ipswich/Springfield line) is a 5-minute walk away.

For people with limited mobility, the multi-level carpark provides easy access to level 2, which has lift access to our clinic.
