**Dr Christopher Go is a subspecialised vitreoretinal ophthalmologist with extensive experience in the medical and surgical management of retinal and macular disorders. He offers care for conditions including epiretinal membrane, macular holes and macular degeneration, as well as retinal vein occlusions, retinal detachment, diabetic eye disease and floaters.**

Having completed four rigorous clinical retinal fellowships in Liverpool UK, Hong Kong, Melbourne and Taiwan, Dr Go is a skilled surgeon with internationally accredited expertise in complex vitreoretinal and cataract cases.

Dr Go has extensive experience in cataract surgeries and vitreoretinal procedures, including scleral buckles and vitrectomies. He has experience with a wide range of premium intraocular lenses (IOLs) – including toric and presbyopia-correcting IOLs – and also offers intricate cataract surgeries such as sutureless scleral-fixated IOLs.

Dr Go is fluent in English, Mandarin and Cantonese.

### BACKGROUND

Dr Go received his Bachelor of Medicine and Doctor of Medicine at the University of New South Wales. He went on to complete his ophthalmology training at the prestigious Sydney Eye Hospital network and completed a senior ophthalmology registrar year at Westmead Hospital. Dr Go also obtained post-graduate qualifications – a Master of Public Health from the University of New South Wales and a Master of Medicine (Ophthalmic Science) from the University of Sydney.

Dr Go then completed four comprehensive sub-speciality clinical retinal fellowships across the globe. He completed a medical retina and cataract fellowship at Monash Health, Melbourne, and retina fellowships at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital, Taiwan, and Hong Kong University, Hong Kong. He also undertook a vitreoretinal fellowship at Liverpool University Hospital, UK.

In addition to his clinical practice, Dr Go is dedicated to the education and training of future doctors. He is an examiner for the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Ophthalmologists (RANZCO), Adjunct Associate Lecturer at the University of New South Wales and Conjoint Clinical Lecturer at Sydney University.

Dr Go is committed to contributing to ophthalmic scientific advancements and research. He has an extensive portfolio of research papers and presentations published in some of the top international ophthalmology journals. He is also an invited reviewer with several international peer-reviewed journals including the esteemed *American Journal of Ophthalmology Case Reports* (AJOCR) and has presented at numerous international conferences including the Royal Australian and New Zealand College of Ophthalmologists (RANZCO) Congress 2024 and Asia-Pacific Academy of Ophthalmology (APAO) Congress 2024.

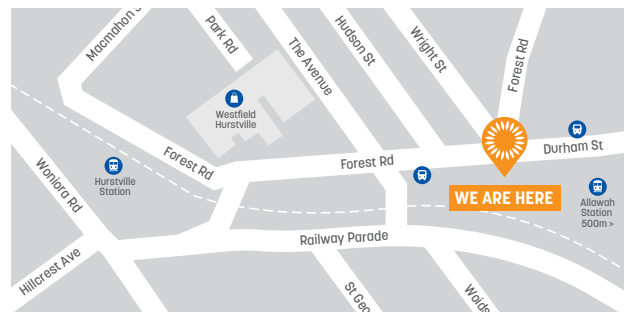
